Biblical Teaching

We value biblical teaching because it is central to God's work of transforming lives personally & collectively

Implications:

- 🔱 We encourage intentional and regular use of the Bible for reading, study and meditation; in individual and group settings, wherever possible.
- 4 We promote Bible Study not merely for the increase of knowledge, but to discover life transformational principles applicable to daily life.
- igl4 We pursue change and growth in our lives as we respond to the power of the Holy Spirit and to his challenge towards Christlike character and behavioural growth.

Dependent Prayer

We value prayer because it expresses our dependence on God, reveals our devotion to God, and resources our service for God.

Matthew 21:22 1 Thessalonians 5:17 Acts 17:28

Implications:

- 🖊 We encourage the discipline of prayer collectively and individually to communicate with God, at every opportunity and for every need
- 4 We seek to know the will of Christ through prayerful study of his word.
- 4 We plan special times of prayer for the church family to respond to God together and to understand his will.

Sharing Faith

We value sharing the Good News of Jesus Christ in the whole world, because all lost people matter to God, and through this Good News people come into a personal relationship with God.

Implications:

- 4 We encourage intentional personal relationships to provide opportunities to serve others and to share our faith
- 4 Our preaching and practices intentionally focus on the Gospel and its practical application to our present world.
- 4 We promote resources and opportunities that assist the development of our ability to share our faith.
- 4 During our meetings and in personal situations, we call for a personal commitment to following Jesus' way of life.
- We work with other Churches and Christian community organisations.

Believing Community

We value the Church as a community of Christian believers, where we can together serve God, and use our individual gifts to His glory

Implications:

- 4 We believe that every Christian is an active minister of Jesus, in that they are uniquely shaped to serve God in this world, through and for his church.
- 4 We have a responsibility to use our gifts in the service of Jesus Christ.
- 🖊 As a community of believers, we worship, fellowship and serve together for the honour of Jesus Christ in obedience to His desires, and for our mutual benefit.
- 🖊 We baptise Christians into the believing community as a significant public declaration of their faith in Jesus.

God-honouring Worship

We value worship as a whole of life experience, because through it we honour God and affirm His worth

Implications:

- 4 We see ourselves as living lives of sacrifice as opposed to excess, as an identification with and adherence to the claims of Jesus over us.
- 4 We are a people of praise, who want to be living lives and speaking words of praise about God.
- Our meetings often involve songs of praise and worship of God
- ullet We seek to live lives that align with the values that Jesus displayed as an example to us of how our faith &practice agree.
- 🖊 We appreciate the different expressions and experiences of faith and worship that are in line with our Biblical understanding of who God is and what he requires of us.
- 🔱 Not only do we seek to do this as individuals who are accountable to God, we see the same disciplines being expressed through our church together.
- 🖊 We recognize that all our possessions are given by God & we seek to use them to honour Him & serve others.
- 4 We celebrate the Lord's Supper in obedience to Jesus' command to remember his saving work until he returns.

Inclusive Relationships

We value all people as being equally loved by God and created by him in his image, but understand that everyone needs a Saviour

Implications:

- 4 Without compromising our Christian faith, we are relationally inclusive rather than exclusive.
- 🖊 We focus our ministries around the needs of people, therefore, following the example of Jesus.
- 4 We are a multi-generational, multi-cultural community and appreciate the diversity that brings to our community
- We offer practical assistance to those in need locally & globally.
