Grace – More Than Amazing

Songs have been composed, books have been written, and sermons have been preached about how amazing "Grace" is. I fully agree that God's grace really is amazing. However, the more I think about it the more I am convinced that "amazing" isn't the only descriptive that may be applied to grace. There is something about grace that is quite radical. Amazing- yes but also radical. The more I study God's grace the more I realize how little I know about it.

Two weeks ago we were thinking about the Hebrew word "hesed" often translated as kindness but in fact so much more than kindness that it is impossible to translate by a single word. It is equivalent to the New Testament word "grace". God describes himself as "abounding in "hesed" or "grace".

2 Samuel 9 is the beautiful story about David and Mephibosheth. Today we will investigate the radical nature of grace in this unfolding story.

John Bunyan captured one radical element of grace when he said "You have never really lived until you have done something for someone who can never repay you"
