**Generation Next!!****Bible Reading:** Psalm 78:1-8

TO ALL THE KIDS WHO WERE BORN IN THE 1930's 40's, 50's, 60's & 70's! 1<sup>st</sup>, we survived being born to mothers who smoked &/or drank while they carried us. They took aspirin, ate blue cheese dressing, tuna from a can, & didn't get tested for diabetes. Then after that trauma, our baby cribs were covered with bright coloured lead-based paints. We had no childproof lids on medicine bottles, doors or cabinets & when we rode our bikes, we had no helmets, not to mention, the risks we took hitchhiking. As children, we would ride in cars with no seat belts/air bags. Riding in the back of a pick up on a warm day was always a special treat. We drank water from the garden hose & NOT from a bottle. We shared 1 soft drink with 4 friends, from 1 bottle & NO 1 actually died from this. We ate cupcakes, white bread & real butter & drank soda pop with sugar in it, but we weren't overweight because WE WERE ALWAYS OUTSIDE PLAYING! We would leave home in the morning & play all day, as long as we were back when the streetlights came on. No 1 was able to reach us all day, & we were O.K. We would spend hours building our go-carts out of scraps & then ride down the hill, only to find out we forgot the brakes. After running into the bushes a few times, we learned to solve the problem. We did not have Play-stations, Nintendo's, X-boxes, no video games at all, no 99 channels on cable, no Netflix, no surround sound, no iPhone, no computers/iPad, no Internet/Internet chat rooms. WE HAD FRIENDS & we went outside & found them! We fell out of trees, got cut, broke bones & teeth & there were no lawsuits from these accidents. We ate worms & mud pies made from dirt, & the worms did not live in us forever. We were given BB guns for our 10<sup>th</sup> birthdays, made up games with sticks & tennis balls and although we were told it would happen, we did not put out very many eyes. We rode bikes or walked to a friend's house & knocked on the door or rang the bell, or just yelled for them! Little League had tryouts & not everyone made the team. Those who didn't had to learn to deal with disappointment.
