### **First Aid Training- Refunds**

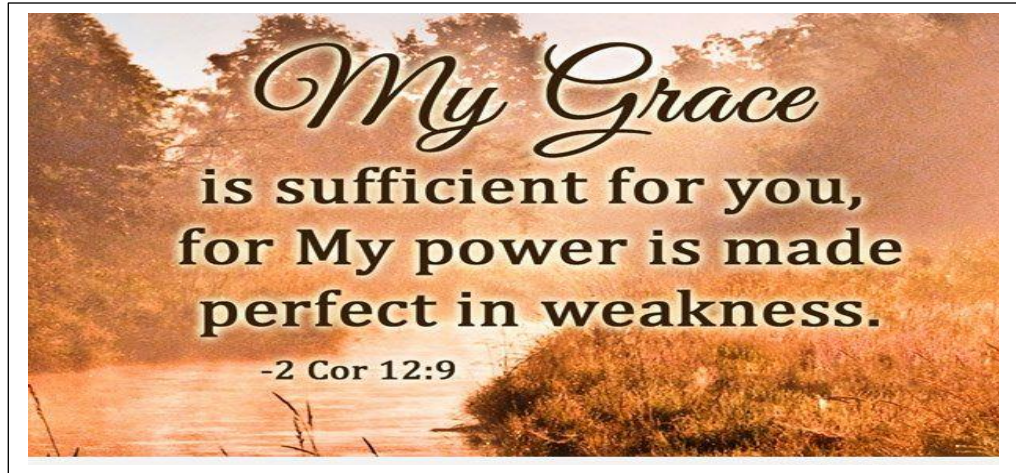
