In Loving Memory of Paul Oswald Rooney: Born 9th June 1944 and left to be with Jesus on the 30th August 2020

My Testimony: By Paul Rooney

I was born in 1944, my parents had a mixed farm in Capalaba. I went to a one teacher school with 28 students from grade 1-8. It was there that I heard the word Devil, this was because I am left handed. I got into a lot while writing with my left hand. My teacher used to get angry with me and say, it was the Devil's works. My parents went broke on the farm and moved to Wynnum when I was about 11. It was hard going to a new school and being dyslexic wasn't easy and I was always in trouble; my school years were not great. The first time I heard about God was in R.E, though my parents were not religious, with my dad being anti-God, but mum always prayed & was told that if you pray God would help. I prayed but didn't get any better at school. I did not pass grade 8 and left school. I thought I would find a job and work the best I could. I worked in a welding shop and it took me 7 years to get my trade certificate; ever since then I have always been employed. I got married in 1965 and moved to Burpengary in 1970 on an 11acre plot. My 2 daughters went to Burpengary State School and the Deception Bay Baptist Church used to do R.E there, though it was only a small community and some of the parents formed a house church. I was told about a men's group who was having a guest speaker called Barry Smith speak one day, so I decided to come along as I knew most of the men. I spoke to Barry and told him I am good enough, he told me to read the Gospel of John. Because I was a good husband and father, I didn't drink much or smoke or gamble. I only swore in men's company but I would never use the Lord's name in vain. I would rather cut wood for a day than read for an hour. Being bought up on a farm you became a conservationist and not throw anything away, I wanted to look after the environment. One day I went fishing at Scarborough on a new moon evening. The sky was clear, which was incredible. All of a sudden, I saw a piece of rubbish in the sea and said that God would get even with them; WOW I didn't even know God nor the Lord Jesus Christ. I said to my then wife that I would like to talk to the pastor and on the 11th of April 1980 I gave my life to the Lord Jesus Christ. This does not mean life will be perfect. My first wife left me after 25 years of marriage. I was broken hearted but Jesus has never left me and I know He never will. I can now read my Bible as today's versions are easier. I've read through the Bible 3 times and am about a third of the way through it again. I met my second wife Louise at the Burpengary Baptist Church and we have been married for nearly 20 years. I thank the Lord for saving me.
