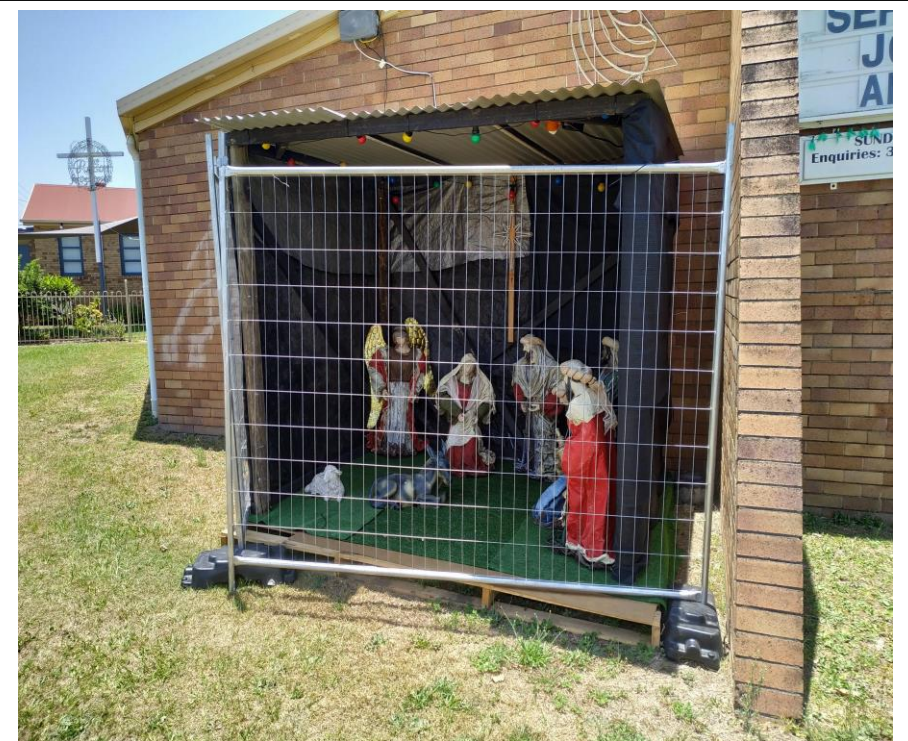
**Help us find our Nativity Pieces**
