“Light Up” Ukraine!

Winter is fast approaching in Ukraine when daytime temperatures average - 5 °C. Can you imagine what life will be like now the Russians are systematically bombing the electricity and water supply infrastructure?
With no power – how does one keep warm, provide meals, keep contact with the rest of the world when phones can't be charged and no Wi-Fi?
What can we as a church do to help?!

Churches in Ukraine are asking for generators to set themselves up as “Light Hubs” – in order to open their doors during the times when power is down. People from the community will be invited to come in to charge phones, have hot tea and soup, access hot water to mix baby formula etc.

Our church's Christmas project this year is to fund one of these generators. The cost of a suitable size generator purchased from one of the European countries and transported to Ukraine is around AU-\$3000.

The churches of Ukraine have been at the forefront of providing humanitarian aid - distributing food and clothing to the destitute cities and villages these past 9 months of war. They are places of Light, Hope and Care!

Russia is destroying the country but not the church! This is the time for the Church of Ukraine to shine it's light – literally and spiritually.

Let's "Light up Ukraine" to the Glory of God!
